About the Program

The Advanced Curriculum Enrichment Program provides a vibrant, high quality learning environment which ensures that intellectually talented students are challenged to reach their academic potential and find their personal style. Learning and teaching programs are tailored to the specialised needs of these students and offer a pathway to university and a lifelong career. In addition students have many opportunities to participate in extracurricular activities such as public speaking, debating, competitions, curriculum based excursions and incursions. Students who are not placed initially in the ACE Program and demonstrate talent may also be considered for the Program in future years based upon their results.

The Course

Basketball Excellence Program

About the Program:

The Ballajura Basketball Excellence program is a school-based sporting program that provides all students the opportunity to develop specific skills, knowledge and experiences in basketball. Theory sessions, game skills, fitness, coaching and nutrition will be embedded throughout the program.

Students will have the opportunity to develop their skills in a broad range of technical, tactical and physical components through competitions as well as the possibility of interschool tournaments and camps.

The Course

- 2 sessions per week (in lieu of mainstream Physical Education)
- Compete in Junior/Senior interschool Basketball carnivals and tournaments
- Coaching clinics from invited WABL/NBL coaches/players
- Opportunities to coach and referee at primary school events.
- Students accepted to join the program must maintain academic standards, comply with attendance guidelines, and REACH values.



Music Excellence Program

About the program:

The Ballajura Community College Music Excellence Program offers an exciting and progressive music program with specialist music instruction for students in years seven to ten. The program includes class music, instrumental studies and ensemble performance.

The Course:

Students may enrol in the program as:

- Continuing Instrumental (Continuing from the Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS) primary school program) on flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, electric guitar, bass guitar, percussion (drums), classical guitar or vocals.
- Beginning Instrumental (Places offered according to availability). Places may be offered in flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, electric guitar, bass guitar, percussion (drums), classical guitar or vocals.
- Private Instrumental (Enrolled in class music and ensemble only. This option is only for students who study an instrument outside of school with a qualified private tutor).

Music Ensembles:

All students in the Music Excellence Program are required to participate in an ensemble. Students who are selected for beginner instruments will attend ensemble when their instrumental skills reach the required standard. Our ensembles include:

- Junior Contemporary Band
- Senior Contemporary Band
- Classical Guitar Ensemble
- Choir
- Junior Concert Band
- Senior Concert Band

Performance

As part of an ensemble provides students with the opportunity for practical and creative expression. Ensemble performances are our most effective way of sharing the talent and achievements of our students and are presented in a variety of settings including festivals, concerts, and school-based performances.

Senior School opportunities

CUA20220 Certificate II in Creative Industries qualification available for year 11& 12 students. This qualification reflects the role of individuals with the skills and knowledge to work in different environments that include music performance, staging, lighting and sound, theatre, scenery and set construction, screen and media, film production and entertainment customer service.
